A MESSAGE FROM THE PE STAFF

Thank you all for your support this year, particularly in supporting children at events, collecting them promptly after clubs, and providing transport – it is greatly appreciated.

A few points about the PE kit from September.

- From September, if a child wants to wear tracksuit bottoms, they must be purchased from Monkhouse.

 This is all children, juniors and infants. The school has informed Monkhouse.
- A reminder, girls may now wear shorts for PE/games.
- When purchasing your next pair of school trainers, please ensure they are predominantly black.
- Maybe only buy trainers with laces if your child can tie their own, or if you intend to teach them how
 to tie laces over the summer.



• Staff would prefer that no earrings be worn on PE days. If your child must wear earrings, they should be a simple stud only. They should either be removed for PE or taped over; please could parents provide the necessary tape.

We hope you will keep your children as active as possible over the summer, as it is so good for them physically, socially, cognitively and emotionally.
