





### SPORTS CREW – Mr Busby

Mr Busby is looking for one child from each of Years 2-6 to form the Sports Crew for 2025/2026. The Sports Crew helps organise events in school; they give feedback on all things active and provide a voice for all pupils in their respective year groups.
