PARENTS EVENINGS

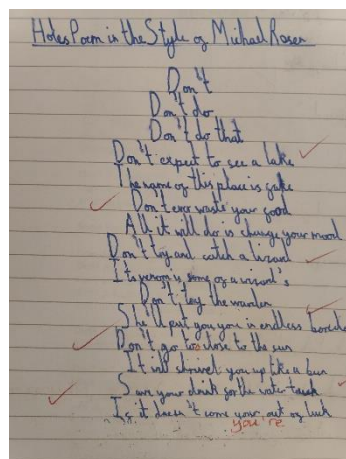

- 10.40 am Infants – Years 1 & 2

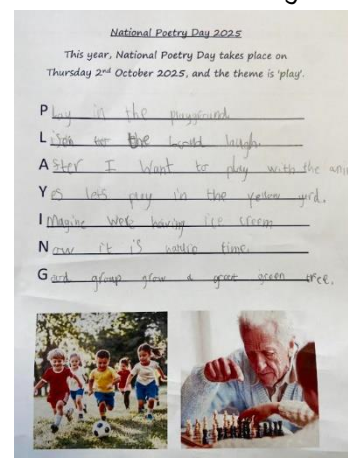
Any child from Year 1 upwards wishing to run is very welcome. Further details next week.
